Tom Bargas, chairman of the crew, has scheduled a pickup event for Saturday, October 7 starting at 7:30 am for the South side of Schulenburg along Highway 77. Meet at Leo’s Stop N Shop at 7:25 am for details. They will go south to the county line providing they have enough help. Your help is needed and greatly appreciated!

Congratulations to Brother Knight Rodney Kalich, he was the Knights in Action winner of a \$15 gift card to Kountry Bakery for showing up in his blue KC shirt and working at the Holman picnic. Lastly, our 33rd Annual Schulenburg Knights of Columbus Turkeyfest is right around the corner. This 3+day event needs your help to be successful. Friday at noon starts with the baking of the 72 pans of cornbread. Friday at 4 pm, we will be cutting up vegetables like: onions, celery, bell peppers and 400 lbs of broccoli along with filling 2000 cups of cranberries. We need alittle extra help to get all this done in a timely manner. On Saturday morning at 7:30 am, we will be baking the turkey roast, grinding up vegetables and then at about noon pulling turkey meat from the pits. **We would appreciate everyone showing up and working at least 4 hours getting all the different jobs done and don’t forget to clean up your work station before you leave.** Saturday at 1:30 pm we will be mixing the broccoli salad together. Saturday at 3 pm, we will be mixing the dry ingredients for the dressing together. On Sunday, October 16th at 5:30 am we will be mixing, panning, and baking our famous homemade dressing. We are planning for 75 pans this year, so hopefully we can fill all 2000+ plates and have some to sell at 12:30 pm in the kitchen (no early dressing sales, first come, first serve and no complaining when it’s out it’s out). Turkey meat will go on the pits starting at 6 am, with gravy being made soon after. Mixed vegetables start at approximately 8 am. Dinner plates will be served starting at 10:30am, but you know we are known to start when the food is ready. The line will probably be to the High Hill FM 2672 turnoff so please come work the five serving lines to help get the plates ready and keep the line moving smoothly. There are a lot of jobs to be done, they are all important to the grand scheme of things. The reason we have so many people on each workers list is so the jobs get done in a timely manner. We need your help, so let’s all pull together and make this another successful event for the Schulenburg KCs. Our to go plates will be \$15 each. The to-go plates will consist of turkey, the best homemade dressing around, mixed vegetables w/cheese sauce, broccoli salad and cranberries. Men, women and children of all ages are more than welcomed to attend, there is something for everyone no matter what your condition is we will accommodate. Your help and generosity is greatly appreciated to make this another successful KC event.
